1. **Call to Order**
Chair Jorgensen read the mission statement.
2. **Public Comment**

None abstained from voting.
4. **Community Conversations**
Chair Jorgensen provided an overview of the Community Conversations Event. The Committee received support from the City Commission to host additional events in the future. The Committee discussed hosting two more events in 2024. They will seek community input regarding discussion topics and guest speakers. Chair Jorgensen will reach out to the Bismarck Veterans Memorial Public Library to reserve Meeting Room A for events in July and November. Members of the subcommittee will meet to discuss topics and possible panelists and report back at the May meeting.
