





Writing on North Dakota: An author conversation with Clay Jenkinson and Sarah Vogel. Moderated by Amy Sisk of the Bismarck Tribune.

Join us for a conversation between two well-known local authors, reflecting on their recently published books, how the people and landscape of North Dakota infuse their writing, and their hopes for state's future.

Clay Jenkinson is a humanities scholar, author, and host of the nationally syndicated radio program, *The Thomas Jefferson Hour*. His most recent book, *The Language of Cottonwoods: Essays on the Future of North Dakota* reflects on the state's spirit of place and cultural identity, outlining a vision for a cultural renaissance at the heart of the continent.

Sarah Vogel is an attorney, advocate, former North Dakota Commissioner of Agriculture, and author of *The Farmer's Lawyer*. Her memoir, rooted in the state's prairie populist history, recalls her David vs. Goliath legal battle on behalf of family farmers against the federal government during the 1980s farm crisis – published as another crisis takes shape in rural America today.

Amy Sisk is lead energy reporter at *The Bismarck Tribune*. A native of Seattle, she previously reported for WESA, the NPR member station in Pittsburgh, as well as Prairie Public Radio.
