### **Bismarck Library Receives National Grant Highlighting Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Procedures**

Bismarck Veterans Memorial Public Library, through the Bismarck Library Foundation, Inc., was one of a handful of facilities in the United States selected to receive a grant from the American Society of Radiologic Technologists (ASRT) National Library Partnership. Grant funds will be used to purchase books that focus on radiologic technology's role in health care and society.

Sponsored by the ASRT, the grant commemorates the discovery of the x-ray by Wilhelm Conrad Roentgen on Nov. 8, 1895.

Bismarck Veteran's Memorial Public Library will feature a book display that highlights the history of the radiologic sciences, technology advances from the past century, and information about radiologic technology. The display will be up through the end of December.

ASRT is the world's largest radiologic science organization, representing more than 155,000 radiologic technologists, the professionals who perform medical imaging and radiation therapy procedures.
