## **CAMPERS & TRAILERS NOT TO BE PARKED ON BISMARCK RESIDENTIAL STREETS**

**BISMARCK, N.D.** – The Bismarck Police Department would like to remind the community about the parking of campers and trailers on Bismarck residential streets from December 1- March 31.

“It is unlawful for any person to park or leave standing any boat, bumper pull travel trailer, fifth wheel trailer, pull type camper, motor home, house car, bus, mini motor home, or trailer on the public right-of-way in any residentially zoned area from December 1 to March 31.

Any person violating this section is subject to a fine of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) per each day of the violation.”

A boat, bumper pull travel trailer, fifth wheel trailer, pull type camper, motor home, house car, bus, mini motor home, or trailer parked or left standing in violation of this section for a consecutive period longer than forty-eight hours shall be considered abandoned, and it may be towed by the Police Department. The owner would be responsible for the tow bill as well as any storage costs before it is released.

The reason for prohibiting parking of these vehicles in residential areas over winter is they hinder snow removal operations. Your cooperation in removing these vehicles from Bismarck residential streets prior to December 1st is appreciated.
